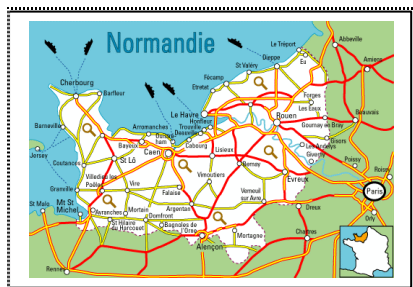


After the AIUTA Congress in Reims
Enjoy a discovery of Normandy and Brittany in 6 days/5 nights

This roundtrip offers you the opportunity to discover a high spot of impressionist period, a recent page of history, a trip deep in the mysteries of medieval christendom, the magics of King Arthur Legend, a scientific approach of megalithic civilizations in southern Brittany, and the marvellous light of the Gulf of Morbihan.

Day 1 : Sunday, September 24 A short way to Normandy : Giverny, Rouen



Departure from Reims after breakfast Meet your bilingual tour guide.
DeLuxe coach for the whole trip and transfers
Take the direction to Giverny and "les jardins de Claude Monet."
Lunch
And a drive to Rouen, capital of Normandy, and "hundred bell towers city"
Dinner and accommodation in Rouen.
Walk by night in the "Gros Horloge" quarter, "Vieux marché" square (where Joan of Arc was burnt), and Cathedral place.

Day 2 Monday 25th



Rouen, Le Havre, Honfleur, Caen

Visit the Cathedral of Rouen (often painted by Monet).
Departure to the Pont de Normandie via the Abbeys road.
Arrival at the poetical harbour of Honfleur for lunch.
Strolling along the docks and historical center
Direction to Caen via Deauville smart beach.
Visit one of Caen Abbeys
Dinner and accommodation in Caen

Day 3 Tuesday 26th



D-Day 6 Juin 1944 : The Battle of Normandy
Landing beaches of the D-Day

Pegasus Bridge, landing beaches of the D-Day, Arromanches (Movies Arromanches 360).
Lunch .
"Tapisserie de Bayeux".
A curve to la Pointe du Hoc, then direct road to the south to reach Mont Saint Michel in the late afternoon.
Dinner and accommodation nearby.

Day 4 Wednesday 27th



Le Mont Saint Michel

High spot of architecture inspired by religious spirit during the 11th to 12th centuries, the Mont Saint Michel is a jewel of world patrimony. (Unesco world heritage).

Commented visit of the abbey (2 h), and presentation of the present project to restore the insular character of the Mount.

Lunch in the Bay.

Direction to Saint Malo, the "City of privateers".

Walking around intra muros and alongside the ramparts.

Free time in Saint Malo

Dinner and accommodation in Saint Malo, or nearby.

Day 5 Thursday 28th



Bretagne from north to south : History and Legends of the French Brittany Celtic World

Crossing Brittany, and stop in the Forest of Broceliande, deep in the Legend of King Arthur, in the Arthurian Imaginary Center. Meet the founder of this Center, and then, visit the Chapel of Trehorenteuc, heart of Brocéliande.

Lunch in a country inn.

Reach the southern coast and the world famous Carnac stones lines

Visit this site as well as the "dolmen Table des Marchand" in Locmariaquer, two most significant monuments of the Neolithic period.

Dinner in a typical creperie (pancakes and cider),

Accommodation in Vannes

Day 6 Friday 29th



Gavrinis :the masterpiece of neolithic architecture in the Gulf of Morbihan

Boarding to Gavrinis Island and private visit of this world famous cairn, guided by an historian, specialist of Neolithic monuments.

Apart from its insularity, the peculiarity of Gavrinis consists in engraved stones, a treasure of celtic symbols.

For a group of 30 persons minimum, possibility of a cruise through the Gulf of Morbihan, disembarking at the harbour of Port-Navalo.

Lunch on the yacht harbour of Le Crouesty before taking the road back to Paris via Nantes (possibility of air connection at Nantes-Atlantique Airport, if personal convenience).
