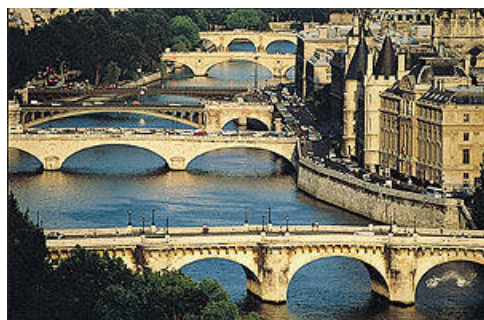


**After the AIUTA Congress in Reims**  
**Enjoy a discovery of Paris and Burgundy in 5 days / 4 nights**

After Reims, a panoramic vision of modern Paris and its most famous spots, but also a research of the genuine atmosphere of old Paris, in the time of Rabelais, when the students wore the name of "escoliers". Then, a ride by coach direct to Burgundy, with "œnology" or wine science as linking line. You will then discover all connections of wine arts with history, architecture, farmer traditions, and also economy and landscapes as we can admire them today.

**Day 1 :**  
**Sunday, Sept 24th, 2006**



***La Tour Eiffel, La Seine, le Quartier latin***

Departure in the morning from Reims to Paris with a Deluxe coach  
Check in at a 3 star hotel in the center of the city  
Meet your bilingual Tour guide  
Remittance of your Paris Visit card (2 days) for all accompanied rides in Paris (bus, metro)  
Lunch on your own  
Entrance to Eiffel Tower 1<sup>st</sup> floor  
Cruise on the River Seine  
09:00 pm Dinner in a cellar of the Quartier Latin, between Notre Dame and le Panthéon, : stones and girders of a 13<sup>th</sup> century, with a French atmosphere created by environment, music and chansons  
Night and breakfast at the hotel

**Jour 2**  
**Monday Sept 25, 2006**



***A commented panoramic tour, Le Louvre Museum***

On board a parisian bus, a commented panoramic visit of monuments and urban sceneries of Paris  
Lunch on your own, with help and advice of tour guide, possibly at the Louvre Cafeteria.  
Entrance to museum « Le Louvre », (Option : see our final paragraph for private lecturer in english per group of maximum 20 persons)  
Dinner in a typical parisian brewery  
Possibility (Option : see our final paragraph) of a show with Champagne at Cabaret « Paradis latin »  
Night and breakfast at the hotel

**Jour 3**  
**Tuesday, Sept 26th**



**Discovering Burgundy : Vezelay and Côtes de Nuits**

Depart from hotel by coach to Burgundy.  
Stop at Vezelay for the visit of the wonderful basilica and the "Colline éternelle" with a local guide, Lunch in the heart of old city  
In Côtes de Nuits, meet and greet service by our correspondent on the spot, who will be your guide for 3 days.  
First initiation to Oenology with the visit of **Château du Clos de Vougeot** seat of a famous Wine Brotherhood : the « Chevaliers du Tastevin », then, in the North of Beaune, you will discover the special vintage wines of "Côtes de Beaune" and "Côtes de Nuits".  
Explanations and wine tastings on the spot.  
Arrival Beaune Check in at your hotel  
Dinner in a cellar in the centre of Beaune (regional dishes and cheeses)

**Jour 4**  
**Wednesday, Sept 27<sup>th</sup>**



**Beaune and the northern surroundings**

Breakfast  
Visit the former hospital « **Hospices de Beaune** » with famous roof made of multicolor tiles.  
Main centres of interest : The big hospital room, the chapel, the galley .  
Before lunch, you will pursue your wine tastings in the cellar  
" la **Cave des Cordeliers**", then enjoy the market menu : Tasting of 6 vintages accompanied with local fresh products, for instance :  
(**Bourgogne Aligoté** Dé de Jambon Persillé **Savigny-lès-Beaune Blanc** Toast de Foie Gras Maison **Monthélie** Confit de Lapereau Tomates cerises farcies **Fixin** Croustade de Magret de Canard sur feuille de Chêne **Marc de Bourgogne** Epoisse sur pain d'Epices **Crémant de Bourgogne** Tartelette au Cassis, Mousse au Chocolat Mousse à la Vanille et Crème Brulée  
Then discover the rich architecture of Beaune while walking around in the heart of old city with your tour guide. Free time for shopping  
For dinner, you will go to the « Mountain of Beaune » in order to enjoy a regional cuisine in a traditional « Auberge »  
Overnight at the hotel

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**Jour 5**  
**Thursday Sept 28<sup>th</sup>**



### ***The South of Beaune, its vineyards, and secret Roman Art***

After breakfast, departure by coach, with our local guide, in order to discover the small villages but famous vineyards like **Pommard, Volnay, Monthélie, Auxey-Duresses, Meursault, ....**

Accompanied by our guide, we propose a private visit of a Château with a small wine museum and the best intimate conditions to taste the wines of the property. At the Pommard Cellar, great choice of quality products for your personal collection.

Lunch takes place in a picturesque and convivial restaurant in Meursault. All along the way, your guide will propose stop stops to admire the numerous treasures of Roman art, flourishing not only in the big cities, but also in the most simple villages or even hamlets.

Departure time will be calculated according to the schedules of air companies for students to have to go back home from Paris.

- LE LOUVRE :  
Our bilingual guide is not allowed to speak as a lecturer in the Museum Le Louvre. The service of an official Louvre Lecturer has to be ordered in addition to entrance (1 lecturer for maximum 20 persons). If a lecturer is required, the theme of visit will be the same for the whole group.  
Without lecturer : Everyone choses to visit the part of the Museum he is interested in. Our guide coordinates and gathers the individuals at the meeting point. He also gives private explanations and replies to your questions  
Private LOUVRE Lecturer : : About 35 € for the group (maximum 25/30 personnes per group)
